SEARHC'S INVESTMENT IN SOUTHEAST ALASKA

SEARHC supports the economy of Southeast Alaska in a multitude of ways. Over the past several years, SEARHC has invested millions of dollars into our Southeast Alaskan communities. SEARHC devotes more than \$186 million annually to employee salaries, wages and benefits. More than \$450 million in additional projects are underway that will come online by the end of 2025. Vintage Park Campus, Juneau

SEARHC broke ground on the Vintage Park Campus in summer 2022 with construction complete in January 2024. Centrally located in Juneau's Mendenhall Valley, Vintage Park services include: Behavioral Health, Imaging, Lab, Optometry, Pediatrics, Pediatric Physical Rehabilitation, Primary Care and Urgent Care. Mt. Edgecumbe Medical Center, Sitka

SEARHC also broke ground in summer 2022 on the new Mt. Edgecumbe Medical Center (MEMC) in Sitka. The new state-of-the-art healthcare facility will offer expanded services to meet the demand of local and referred patients across Southeast Alaska. MEMC is a critical access hospital providing inpatient acute care services, emergency care, surgery and a broad array of ancillary and outpatient clinic services. The new Mt.
